Warrenton Quilt Days

April 15 - 17 ...



The first ever "Warrenton Quilt Days", a three-day quilt festival, the brainchild of **Quilt Lizzy's** Susan Harris and Sheila Carver of **Magnolia Manor Plantation B&B**, is set to complement a spring tour of historic homes presented by **Preservation Warrenton** April 15-17. Look for thousands of visitors in April!

Quilts will be on public display in the historic houses and buildings of the town. In conjunction with Preservation Warrenton's biannual Home Tour of 13 homes and buildings Viewer's Choice quilts will be on display for public voting. Quilts will also be displayed in Courthouse Square, Warrenton businesses, and the Warrenton Cotton Gin. Admission will be required for the Home Tour and the Cotton Gin.

Quilts will be accepted for the show from January 10, 2016, until March 1, 2016, at Quilt Lizzy, 110 E. Macon St., Warrenton. A nominal fee will be charged for each quilt entry.

Several nationally recognized quilting experts and certified quilt appraisers have already committed to participating in the event.

Food will be available for purchase through the "Taste of the Town" hosted by Warrenton churches and nonprofits

An "Iron Quilter" contest will feature teams competing to see who can finish their quilt first.
